

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 12-12, as amended, by amending section 13 to change the use of certain funds appropriated for Chuuk State Election District No. 3, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 13 of Public Law No. 12-12, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 12-21 and 12-24, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 13. Capital and Human Resource Development.

5 The sum of \$11,415,200, or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
7 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
8 September 30, 2002, for capital improvement, development
9 programs and projects and human resource development. Of the
10 total funds appropriated under this section, \$2,955,926 shall
11 be deemed to come from the capital account funds available
12 under section 211 of the Compact of Free Association, and
13 \$1,387,700 from the funds available under section 216(a)(3)
14 of the Compact of Free Association. The sum appropriated
15 under this section shall be apportioned as follows:

- 16 (1) College of Micronesia-FSM
 - 17 (a) Operations of the College of
 - 18 Micronesia-FSM, including planning
 - 19 and construction of new facilities.....\$ 3,067,000

1 (b) Student assistance for tuition
 2 and housing to be deemed as deriving from
 3 section 216(a)(3) of the Compact of Free
 4 Association PROVIDED that these funds shall
 5 be used strictly for direct financial
 6 assistance to COM-FSM students, and PROVIDED
 7 FURTHER that the co-payment by the student or
 8 the student's parent must be proportionally
 9 the same for each in relation to their total
 10 obligation, and PROVIDED FURTHER that only
 11 students maintaining a passing grade point
 12 average will be eligible to receive these
 13 funds. The funds appropriated under this
 14 subsection shall be apportioned as follows:

8 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
9 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
10 law without such approval.
