

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-100, as amended, by further amending section 1 to modify the use of certain funds appropriated therein for the Southern Namoneas, by further amending section 5 to change a lapse date, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 9-100, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 9-104, 9-129, 9-150, 10-1, 10-116, 12-62, and 12-
3 78 and 13-14, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$5,350,000, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 1997, for the
8 purpose of funding the infrastructure, social and
9 economic development and other needs of the State of
10 Chuuk. The funds appropriated by this section shall be
11 apportioned as follows:

13 Section 2. Section 5 of Public Law No. 9-100, as amended
 14 by Public Laws Nos. 9-104, 9-137, 9-151, 10-20, 10-44, 10-73,
 15 10-116, 10-117, 12-8, 12-62, 13-9 and 13-14, is hereby further
 16 amended to read as follows:

17 "Section 5. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted
 18 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
 19 (1) of section 1 of this act shall be the Chuuk State
 20 Commission on Improvement Projects. The allottee of the
 21 funds appropriated under subsection (2) (a), (2) (b),
 22 (2) (c) and (2) (d) of section 1 of this act shall be the
 23 Teleisom Authority. The allottees of the funds
 24 appropriated under subsection (2) (e) and (2) (f) of
 25 section 1 of this act shall be the mayors of the

1 respective municipalities. The allottee of the funds
2 appropriated under subsection (2)(g), (2)(h) and (2)(i)
3 of section 1 of this act shall be the mayor of Polle
4 Municipality. The allottee of the funds appropriated
5 under subsection (3) of section 1 of this act shall be
6 the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The
7 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (4)
8 and (8) of section 1 of this act shall be the Northern
9 Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of the
10 funds appropriated under subsection (5) of section 1 of
11 this act shall be the Mortlock Development Authority.
12 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
13 (6) of section 1 of this act shall be the Pattiw
14 Development Authority. The allottee of the funds
15 appropriated under subsection (7) of section 1 and
16 subsection (2) of section 4 of this act shall be the
17 Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of
18 Micronesia or the Speaker's designee. The allottee of
19 the funds appropriated under subsection (2) of section 2
20 of this act shall be the Chairman of the Kosrae
21 Utilities Authority, and the allottee of the funds
22 appropriated under subsection (9) of section 2 of this
23 act shall be the Governor of the State of Kosrae. The
24 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
25 (2)(a) and (2)(b) of section 3 of this act shall be the

1 Pohnpei Visitor's Bureau. The allottee of funds
2 appropriated under subsections (1) and (3) of section 4
3 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap.
4 The allottee of all other funds appropriated by this act
5 shall be the President of the Federated States of
6 Micronesia or the President's designee. The allottees
7 shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or
8 so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
9 the purpose specified in this act, and that no
10 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
11 appropriated. The authority of the allottees to
12 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
13 September 30, 2003, except that the authority of the
14 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by subsection
15 (1)(c) of section 1 of this act shall lapse on September
16 30, 2004, and the authority of the allottee to obligate
17 funds appropriated by subsection (3) of section 1 of
18 this act shall lapse on September 30, 2005."

19 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
20 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
21 becoming law without such approval.
