

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 12-50, as amended and restated by Public Law No. 12-53 and amended by Public Law No. 12-74, by amending section 13 thereof to reallocate certain post-secondary educational assistance funds appropriated to Yap State, by amending section 16 thereof to change the allottee for a portion of such funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 13 of Public Law No. 12-50, as amended
2 and restated by Public Law No. 12-53 and amended by Public Law No.
3 12-74, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 13. Capital and Human Resource Development.

5 The sum of \$12,382,572, or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
7 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
8 year ending September 30, 2003, for capital improvement,
9 development programs and projects and human resource
10 development. The sum appropriated under this section
11 shall be apportioned as follows:

12 (1) College of Micronesia - FSM

13 (a) Operations of the College of
14 Micronesia-FSM, including planning, construction
15 of new facilities and maintenance of the
16 newly completed multi-purpose gymnasium 3,220,000

17 (b) Student assistance for tuition

2	(ii) Grants, PROVIDED THAT the	
3	Department of Finance and Administration	
4	of the Federated States of Micronesia

3 Section 2. Section 16 of Public Law No. 12-50, as amended by Public
4 "Section 16. Allotment and management of funds and
5 lapse date.

6 (1) *General Provisions.*

7 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
8 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in
9 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
10 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979;

11 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for
12 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
13 necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in
14 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
15 of the sum appropriated.

16 (2) *Allottees.* The allottees of the funds
17 appropriated by this act are as follows:

18 (a) section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall
19 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

20 (b) section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall
21 be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States
22 of Micronesia;

23 (c) section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall
24 be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
25 Federated States of Micronesia;

1 (d) section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall
2 be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
3 Micronesia;

4 (e) section 6 through 13 - the allottee of these
5 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
6 Micronesia; EXCEPT THAT for the following subsections of
7 section 6 through 13 of this act, the allottees shall
8 be:

9 (i) section 8, subsection (5) - the allottee
10 of these funds shall be the President of the Federated
11 States of Micronesia;

12 (ii) section 8, subsection (8)(a) through
13 (8)(d) - the allottee of these funds shall be Chief
14 Justice of the respective state;

15 (iii) section 13, subsection (1)(a) through
16 (1)(d) - the allottee of these funds shall be the
17 President of the College of Micronesia-FSM;

18 (iv) section 13, subsection (2)(a) through
19 (2)(d) - the allottee of these funds shall be the
20 Governor of the respective state, EXCEPT THAT the
21 allottee for funds allocated to Chuuk State under
22 subsection (2)(c) shall be the Chuuk State Commission on
23 Improvement Projects and the allottee for funds
24 allocated to Yap State under subsection (2)(d)(ii) shall
25 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

1 and

2 (v) Section 13, subsection (15) - the
3 allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of
4 the Supreme Court of the Federated States of Micronesia.

5 (3) *Lapse Dates.* The authority of the allottees to
6 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as
7 of September 30, 2003, EXCEPT that funds appropriated
8 under section 13 of this act shall not lapse."

9 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
10 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
11 becoming law without such approval.
