

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-100, as amended, by amending section 1 thereof, to reallocate funds appropriated for certain grants in the Southern Namoneas in the State of Chuuk, by amending section 6 thereof, to change an allottee of funds, to change the lapse date, and to remove a requirement for consultation with Members of Congress prior to obligating certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 9-100, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 9-104, 9-129, 9-150, 10-1, 10-116, 12-62 and 12-
3 78, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$5,350,000, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 1997, for the
8 purpose of funding the infrastructure, social and
9 economic development and other needs of the State of
10 Chuuk. The funds appropriated by this section shall be
11 apportioned as follows:

20 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 9-100, as amended by
21 Public Laws Nos. 9-104 and 9-137, is hereby further amended to
22 read as follows:

23 "Section 5. All funds appropriated by this act shall
24 be allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for
25 in accordance with applicable law, including, but not

1 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
2 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)
3 of section 1 of this act shall be the [~~Governor of the~~
4 ~~State of Chuuk~~] Chuuk State Commission on Improvement
5 Projects. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
6 subsection (2) (a), (2) (b), (2) (c) and (2) (d) of section
7 1 of this act shall be the Toleisom Authority. The
8 allottees of the funds appropriated under subsection
9 (2) (e) and (2) (f) of section 1 of this act shall be the
10 mayors of the respective municipalities. The allottee
11 of the funds appropriated under subsection (2) (g),
12 (2) (h) and (2) (i) of section 1 of this act shall be the
13 mayor of Polle Municipality. The allottee of the funds
14 appropriated under subsection (3) of section 1 of this
15 act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
16 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated
17 under subsections (4) and (8) of section 1 of this act
18 shall be the Northern Namoneas Development Authority.
19 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
20 (5) of section 1 of this act shall be the Mortlock
21 Development Authority. The allottee of the funds
22 appropriated under subsection (6) of section 1 of this
23 act shall be the Pattiw Development Authority. The
24 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (7)
25 of section 1 and subsection (2) of section 4 of this

1 act shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the
2 Federated States of Micronesia or the Speaker's
3 designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
4 subsection (2) of section 2 of this act shall be the
5 Chairman of the Kosrae Utilities Authority, and the
6 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (9)
7 of section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of the
8 State of Kosrae. The allottee of the funds
9 appropriated under subsection (2) (a) and (2) (b) of
10 section 3 of this act shall be the Pohnpei Visitor's
11 Bureau. The allottee of funds appropriated under
12 subsections (1) and (3) of section 4 of this act shall
13 be the Governor of the State of Yap. The allottee of
14 all other funds appropriated by this act shall be the
15 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or the
16 President's designee. The allottees shall be
17 responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much
18 thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the
19 purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations
20 are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. [~~The~~
21 ~~allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection~~
22 ~~(1) (b) of section 3 of this act shall not obligate any~~
23 ~~funds appropriated therein without first consulting~~
24 ~~with the members of the Pohnpei Delegation to~~
25 ~~Congress.~~] The authority of the allottees to obligate

1 funds appropriated by this act shall [~~not~~] lapse on
2 September 30, 2003, except that the authority of the
3 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by subsection
4 1(c) of section 1 of this act shall lapse on September
5 30, 2004."

6 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President
