

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 6-49, as amended, by amending section 10 for the purpose of changing the allottee of funds previously appropriated for public projects in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 10 of Public Law No. 6-49, as
2 amended by Public Laws Nos. 6-55, 6-96, 6-112, 7-3, 7-26,
3 7-58, 8-124 and 9-032, is hereby further amended to read as
4 follows:

5 "Section 10. Allotment and management of funds and
6 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act
7 shall be allotted, managed, administered, and
8 accounted for in accordance with applicable law,
9 including, but not limited to, the Financial
10 Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds
11 appropriated by section 4 of this act shall be the
12 ~~[President of the Federated States of Micronesia]~~
13 Executive Director of the Chuuk State Commission on
14 Improvement Projects. The allottee of the funds
15 appropriated by subsection (2) of section 1 of this
16 act shall be the Chuuk Organization of Community
17 Action (COCA); the allottee of the funds
18 appropriated by subsection (4) of section 1 shall be
19 the Lower Mortlocks Development Authority; and the

1 allottee of the funds appropriated by subsections
2 (1), (3), (5), (6), (7), (8), (9), (10), and (11) of
3 section 1 and by subsections (1), (2), (3), (4), and
4 (5) of section 2 shall be the Governor of Chuuk
5 State; the allottee of subsection (6) of section 2
6 shall be the Northern Namoneas Development
7 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated
8 under subsection (12) of section 1 of this act shall
9 be the Peace Corps Representative, Chuuk State. The
10 allottees of the funds appropriated by sections 3,
11 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9 of this act shall be the local
12 development authorities of the areas for which the
13 projects are designated. The allottees shall be
14 responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so
15 much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely
16 for the purposes specified in this act, and that no
17 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
18 appropriated. The authority of the allottees to
19 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall not
20 lapse until expended."

21 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
22 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
23 becoming law without such approval.
