

PUBLIC LAW NO. 13-42

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-19, as amended, by amending section 2 thereof to change the use of certain funds appropriated thereunder and by amending section 3 thereof to change the allottee of certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 8-19, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 8-72, 8-80 and 10-45, is hereby further
3 amended to read as follows:

11 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 8-19, as amended by
12 Public Laws Nos. 8-72, 8-107, 9-016 and 9-044, is hereby further
13 amended to read as follows:

14 "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
15 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in
16 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
17 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
18 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
19 (1) (a) of section 2 of this act shall be the PWP
20 Development Authority. The allottee of the funds
21 appropriated under subsections (1) (b) (i) through
22 (1) (b) (v) of section 2 of this act shall be the Southern
23 Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of the
24 funds appropriated under subsection (1) (b) (vi) of
25 section 2 of this act shall be the Secretary of

1 Education of the Federated States of Micronesia. The
2 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
3 (1)(c) of section 2 of this act shall be the Lower
4 Mortlocks Development Authority. The allottee of the
5 funds appropriated under subsection (1)(d) of section 2
6 of this act shall be the Northern Namoneas Development
7 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
8 subsection (1)(e) of section 2 of this act shall be the
9 Pattiw Development Authority. The allottee of the funds
10 appropriated under subsection (1)(f) of section 2 of
11 this act shall be the Saramen Chuuk Academy Board of
12 Directors. The allottee of all other funds appropriated
13 under section 2 of this act shall be the President or
14 the President's designee; PROVIDED, the allottee of the
15 funds appropriated under subsection (3) of section 2 of
16 this act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap. The
17 allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these
18 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
19 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
20 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
21 appropriated. The authority of the allottees to
22 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall not
23 lapse."

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Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
