Your Committee on Health, Education and Social Affairs
("HESA"), to which was referred C.B. No. 13-165, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$405,000 FROM
THE GENERAL FUND OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA FOR
THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2005, FOR THE PURPOSE OF
FUNDING SCHOLARSHIPS FOR POST-SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS, AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.",

begs leave to report as follows:

The intent and purpose of the bill are expressed in its title.

The subject bill would appropriate the remaining Compact 1
funds, for scholarships for post-secondary school students.

The allottee of the funds allocated to each state would be the
governor of that state. However, in the case of Chuuk, the
allottee would be the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement
Projects.

Your Committee recognizes the importance of post-secondary
education to the future development of the FSM. In addition,
your Committee is satisfied that this bill will provide an
effective means of assisting promising students in each of the
states to undertake post-secondary studies in the FSM or
abroad.

Your Committee recommends the following technical amendment:

1. Page 2, line 8 - delete "2006" and insert "2005" in
lieu thereof.

With the foregoing amendment, your Committee on Health, Education
and Social Affairs is in accord with the intent and purpose of
C.B. No. 13-165 and recommends its passage on First Reading, and
that it be placed on the Calendar for Second and Final Reading in
