

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 14-21 by adding a new subsection to section 9 thereof to appropriate funds for Capacity Building purposes; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 Section 9 of Public Law No. 14-21 is
2 here amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resource Development.

4 The sum of \$9,200,568, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
5 hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States
6 of Micronesia from the General Fund of the Federated States of
7 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006, for the
8 following capital improvements, development programs and projects
9 and human resource development. The sum appropriated by this
10 section shall be apportioned as follows:

11 (1) College of Micronesia-FSM.

12 \$6,909,240, or so much thereof as may be
13 necessary, for the operations, programs and projects of
14 the College during fiscal year 2006. The sum
15 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:
