

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 12-50, as amended, by amending section 13 thereof, to change the use of certain funds appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 13 of Public Law No. 12-50, as amended  
2 and restated by Public Law No. 12-53 and amended by Public Laws  
3 Nos.

4 12-74, 13-01 and 13-17, is hereby further amended to read as  
5 follows:

6           "Section 13. Capital and Human Resource Development.

7           The sum of \$12,382,572, or so much thereof as may be  
8 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
9 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
10 year ending September 30, 2003, for capital improvement,  
11 development programs and projects and human resource  
12 development. The sum appropriated under this section  
13 shall be apportioned as follows:
