## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Sections 1 and 2 of Public Law No. 14-67, to change the uses and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein and to make technical changes, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Allotment and management of funds and lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be 6 7 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws, including, but not 8 9 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the 10 amended Compact of Free Association between the United States Government and the Government of the Federated 11 States of Micronesia and its related agreements. The 12 13 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these 14 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used 15 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum 16 17 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated 18 under subsection (4)(a),(c)  $d[\frac{(ii)}{(ii)}]$  and (f) of section 1 19 of this act shall be the Chuuk State Commission on 20 Improvement Project. The allottee of the funds 21 appropriated under subsection (4)(b) of section 1 of 22 this act shall be the Mortlocks Development Commission. 23 [The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection (4) (d) of section 1 of this act shall be the Southern 24 Nomeneas Development Authority]. The allottee of funds 25

1	appropriated under subsection (4)(e) of section 1 of
2	this act shall be the Mayor of Polle. The allottee of
3	funds appropriated under subsections 1,2 and 3 of
4	Section 1 of this act shall be the President of the
5	Federated States of Micronesia. The authority of the
6	allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act
7	shall not lapse."
8	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
9	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
10	becoming law without such approval.
