

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 13-36, as amended, by amending sections 3 and 4 thereof, to change the uses of certain funds previously appropriated for projects and programs in Election District No. 3, Pohnpei State and Election District No. 2, Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 13-36, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 13-49, 13-66, 13-80, 13-92, 14-04 and 14-52, is
3 hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 3. The sum of \$800,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004, to provide
8 funding for social and economic development projects in
9 the State of Pohnpei. The funds appropriated under this
10 section shall be apportioned as follows:

2 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
3 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
4 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004, to provide
5 funding for social and economic development projects in
6 the State of Chuuk. The funds appropriated under this
