

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 13-46, as amended, by amending sections 2 [~~and 9~~], 3, 9 and 13 thereof for the purpose of appropriating an additional sum of \$~~[855,000]~~ 380,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 13-46, as amended by  
2 Public Law No. 13-62, 13-81 and 13-87, is hereby further amended  
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch.

5 The sum of [~~\$13,752,322~~] \$[~~13,882,322~~] 13,862,322, or so  
6 much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated  
7 from the General Fund of the Federated States of  
8 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
9 2005, for the operations of the Executive Branch of the  
10 National Government during fiscal year 2005. The sum  
11 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as  
12 follows:

13 (1) Office of the President

14 \$700,864, for the activities set forth in the  
15 performance budget pages 1 through 2 of the budget book.  
16 Of the funds appropriated, \$35,000 shall be deemed to  
17 come from carryover funds available under section  
18 215(a) (2) of Compact I for communications.

19 (2) Department of Foreign Affairs

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1           \$3,426,792 for the activities set forth in the  
2           performance budget pages 20 through 24 of the budget  
3           book, provided that \$29,000, or so much thereof as may  
4           be necessary, is to be used to provide housing  
5           allowances to consular staff in Honolulu and,  
6           notwithstanding any other section of Public Law No. 13-  
7           46, shall not be reprogrammed or used for any other  
8           purpose. Of the amount appropriated, \$141,800 shall be  
9           deemed to come from carryover funds available under  
10          section 215(a)(2) of Compact I for communications.

11          (3) Department of Finance and Administration  
12          \$2,439,532 for the activities set forth in the  
13          performance budget pages 73 through 77 of the budget  
14          book, provided that \$500,000 of this amount shall be  
15          used to fund a portion of the deficit recorded by the  
16          National Government at the close of fiscal year 2003  
17          (which funds have been reprogrammed for disaster relief  
18          under the President's emergency powers). Of the total  
19          funds appropriated, \$46,914 shall be deemed to come from  
20          carryover funds available under section 215(a)(2) of  
21          Compact I for communications.

22          (4) Department of Economic Affairs  
23          \$1,071,353, for the activities set forth in the  
24          performance budget pages 126 through 132 of the budget  
25          book. Of the total funds appropriated, \$29,381 shall be

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1 deemed to come from carryover funds available under  
2 section 215(a)(2) of Compact I for communications.

3 (5) Department of Transportation, Communication and  
4 Infrastructure  
5 [~~\$1,264,922~~] \$1,314,922, for the activities set forth in  
6 the performance budget pages 183 through 185 of the  
7 budget book; provided that \$50,000 for fuel for the M/S  
8 Voyager shall only be allotted upon the written  
9 acknowledgement of the Speaker of Congress confirming  
10 his receipt of a satisfactory accounting of the M/S  
11 Voyager Revolving Fund, a report on the revenues  
12 generated by the M/S Voyager in FY05 and a plan for  
13 earning revenues or serving the people of the Federated  
14 States of Micronesia during the remaining excursions of  
15 the M/S Voyager in FY05. Of the total funds  
16 appropriated, \$20,000 shall be deemed to come from  
17 carryover funds available under section 215(b)(2) of  
18 Compact I for communications.

19 (6) Department of Health, Education and Social Affairs  
20 \$1,526,808, for a portion of the activities set forth in  
21 the performance budget pages 210 through 216 of the  
22 budget book. Of the total funds appropriated, \$475,200  
23 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the  
24 education sector of the Amended Compact, \$763,234 from  
25 the health sector, and \$111,421 from the environment

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1 sector.

2 (7) Department of Justice

3 [~~\$2,544,538~~] \$~~[2,624,538]~~2,604,538, for the activities  
4 set forth in the performance budget pages 339 through  
5 342 of the budget book provided that no more than  
6 \$31,000 of this amount may be expended on fuel oil for  
7 National Police Patrol boats until the Department has  
8 submitted to Congress an accounting concerning the use  
9 of fuel oil for this purpose in fiscal year 2004,  
10 including a description of each trip taken and the  
11 amount and cost of fuel used for each trip. Of the  
12 total funds appropriated, \$37,000 shall be deemed to  
13 come from carryover funds available under section  
14 215(b) (2) of Compact I for communications, \$48,480 from  
15 carryover funds available under section 216(a) (1) of  
16 Compact I for Maritime Surveillance, and \$47,486 from  
17 carryover funds available under 216(b) of Compact I for  
18 Marine Surveillance.

19 (8) FSM Public Defender Office

20 \$677,513, for the activities set forth in the  
21 performance budget pages 372 through 373 of the budget  
22 book provided that \$16,000, or so much thereof as may be  
23 necessary, is to be used for payment of the professional  
24 premium to any eligible person or persons, and  
25 notwithstanding any other section of Public Law No. 13-

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1           46, shall not be reprogrammed or used for any other  
2           purpose. Of the total funds appropriated, \$9,800 shall  
3           be deemed to come from carryover funds available under  
4           section 215(b) (2) of Compact I for communications.

5           (9) Office of Compact Management  
6           \$100,000 to fund the establishment and operations of an  
7           Office of Compact Management in accordance with Public  
8           Law No. 13-75, provided that these funds shall not be  
9           used to meet the cost of activities that are already  
10          being undertaken with the National Government."

11          Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 13-46, as amended by  
12 Public Laws No. 13-62, 13-81 and 13-87, is hereby further amended  
13 to read as follows:

14          "Section 3. Operating Expenses of the Legislative Branch. The su  
15 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
16 2005, for the operations of the Legislative Branch of  
17 the National Government during the fiscal year 2005, in  
18 order to achieve the activities set forth in the  
19 performance budget pages 380 through 381 of the budget  
20 book. Of the funds appropriated, \$40,000 shall be deemed  
21 to come from the carryover funds available under section  
22 215(b) (2) of Compact I for communications."

23          ~~[Section 2]~~ Section 3. Section 9 of Public Law No. 13-46, as  
24 amended by Public Law No. 13-81 and 13-87, is hereby further  
25 amended to read as follows:

1           "Section 9. Capital and Human Resource Development.

2           The sum of [~~\$7,135,287~~] ~~[\$7,860,287]~~\$7,385,287, or so  
3           much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated  
4           from the General Fund of the Federated States of  
5           Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
6           2005, for the following capital improvements,  
7           development programs and projects and human resource  
8           development. The sum appropriated under this section  
9           shall be apportioned as follows:

10           (1) College of Micronesia-FSM

11                   (a) Operations of the College of Micronesia-FSM,  
12           including planning, construction and maintenance of  
13           college facilities. All funds appropriated  
14           herein shall be deemed to come from funds  
15           available under the education sector of  
16           the Amended Compact except \$500,000 shall be deemed to  
17           come from local revenue [~~\$3,856,067~~] [~~\$4,356,067~~] \$3,856,067

18                   (b) Student assistance for tuition  
19           and housing, COM-FSM, provided that all  
20           of the funds appropriated herein shall be  
21           deemed to come from carryover funds  
22           available under section 216(a)(3) of  
23           Compact I for postsecondary scholarships ..\$           190,000

24                   (c) COM-FSM Yap Campus Facility,  
25           PROVIDED THAT funds appropriated herein

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1	shall be deemed to come from funds available	
2	under the infrastructure development	
3	sector of the Amended Compact .....	\$ 330,000
4	(2) FSM Fisheries and Maritime Institute,	
5	including operations, planning, training,	
6	and construction and maintenance of	
7	facilities and equipment. Of this amount	
8	\$180,050, shall be deemed to come from	
9	funds available under the education sector	
10	of the Amended Compact .....	738,360
11	(3) National Staff Upgrading, PROVIDED	
12	THAT funds appropriated herein shall be	
13	deemed to come from funds available under	
14	the capacity building sector of the	
15	Amended Compact .....	50,000
16	(4) FSM Visitors Bureau provided that,	
17	of this amount, \$40,000 shall be used to	
18	support FSM relations with JATA and	
19	participation in JATA programs and events ..	140,000
20	(5) Economic Statistics Unit Strengthening	75,000
21	(6) Crop Production Improvement .....	27,300
22	(7) Public Enterprise Privatization .....	66,560
23	(8) 2005 World Exposition (Japan) .....	82,000
24	(9) FSM Development Bank - Business	
25	Development Loan Program .....	500,000

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1	(10) MS Caroline Voyager Dry-docking .....	\$ 630,000
2	(11) Patrol boats slipping .....	200,000
3	(12) Project Management Unit (PMU), PROVIDED	
4	THAT the sum appropriated in this line item	
5	shall be deemed to come from funds available	
6	under the infrastructure development	
7	sector of the Amended Compact .....	250,000
