Dear Mr. Speaker:

Your Committee on Ways and Means to which was referred C.B. No. 14-20 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 13-84, BY AMENDING SECTION 1 THEREOF TO CHANGE THE USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS APPROPRIATED THEREIN, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.",

begs leave to report as follows:

The intent and purpose of the bill are expressed in its title.

As indicated by its title, the subject bill changes the use of certain funds previously appropriated by P.L. No. 13-84 for projects in Chuuk Election District No. 5. Specifically, the amount appropriated for a junior high school hot lunch program is reduced by \$15,000; the appropriation for medicine and medical supplies is increased by \$10,000; and \$5,000 is appropriated to cover costs associated with the assembly of a desalination facility. Your committee supports these changes.

Thus, your Committee on Ways and Means is in accord with the intent and purpose of C.B. No. 14-20 and recommends its passage on First Reading, and that it be placed on the Calendar for Second and Final Reading.
