Your Committee on Ways and Means, to which was referred C.B. No. 14-128, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 12-50, AS AMENDED, BY AMENDING SECTION 13 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS APPROPRIATED THEREIN, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.",

The intent and purpose of the bill are expressed in its title.

The subject bill would change the use of certain funds appropriated by Public Law No. 12-50. In particular, \$120,000 originally earmarked for the Houk Airport would be used to purchase a school site, building materials, POL, survey work and site clearance for Pattiw Junior High School.

Your Committee on Ways and Means is in accord with the purpose and intent of C.B. No. 14-128 and recommends its passage on First Reading, and that it be placed on the Calendar for Second and Final Reading.
