

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 1 of Public Law No. 14-67, as amended, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein for Kosrae State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 14-67, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 14-72, 14-82, 14-91, 14-101, 15-06, and 15-16 is  
3 hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$2.1 million, or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the  
6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for  
7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006 for projects  
8 and programs in each state of the Federated States of  
9 Micronesia. The funds appropriated under section 1 of  
10 this act shall be apportioned on the basis of \$150,000  
11 per member of Congress as follows:

13       Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 14-67, as amended by  
14 Public Laws Nos. 14-72, 14-82 and 14-101, is hereby further  
15 amended to read as follows:

16       "Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
17 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
18 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
19 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
20 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the  
21 amended Compact of Free Association between the United  
22 States Government and the Government of the Federated  
23 States of Micronesia and its related agreements. The  
24 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
25 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
26 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that



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1 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
2 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
3 under subsections (4) (a), (c), (d) and (f) of section 1  
4 of this act shall be the Chuuk State Commission on  
5 Improvement Project. The allottee of the funds  
6 appropriated under subsection (4) (b) of section 1 of  
7 this act shall be the Mortlocks Development Commission.  
8 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection  
9 (4) (e) of section 1 of this act shall be the Mayor of  
10 Polle. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
11 subsections 1, 2 and 3 of Section 1 of this act shall be  
12 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia  
13 except that the allottee of funds appropriated under  
14 subsections (2) (b), (2) (c), 2(d) and (2) (f) of Section 1  
15 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap.  
16 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds  
17 appropriated by this act shall lapse on 30 September  
18 2008."

19 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
20 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
21 becoming law without such approval.
