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A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 14-80, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 14-95, 14-99 and 14-104, 15-01, 15-04, the FY 2007 budget, by further amending sections 1, 2, 8, 9 and 12 thereof, for the purpose of appropriating an additional \$240,000 in supplemental funding from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007, to provide for the operations of the Executive Branch, various programs, grants, subsidies, and contributions, Capital and Human Resource Development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

4           allottee of these funds shall be the President of the  
5           College of Micronesia-FSM.

6           (3) Lapse Date. The authority of the allottee to  
7           obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as  
8           of September 30, 2007, EXCEPT the funds appropriated  
9           under sections 8(7)(q), (w), and (x) and 9 of this act,  
10          as well as the \$50,000 appropriated to the Department of  
11          Justice for contractual services shall not lapse."

12          Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
13          President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
14          becoming law without such approval.
