

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate \$41,065,121 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2009, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Shall read as follows: To appropriate the sum of
2 \$41,065,121 from the General Fund of the Federated States of
3 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2009, for the
4 purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the National
5 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies,
6 various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions; and for
7 other purposes. The sum appropriated herein shall be apportioned
8 as follows:

9 Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch. The
10 sum of \$17,250,544 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
11 hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States
12 of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2009, for
13 the purpose of funding the operations of the Executive Branch of
14 the National Government during the fiscal year 2009. The sum
15 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

9 Section 11. Reprogramming. Reprogramming of funds into or
 10 from the personnel budget line items shall not be permitted. The
 11 President may reprogram up to 10% to or from, whichever is less,
 12 from the funds appropriated to each department and office in
 13 section 2 (Operating expenses of the Executive Branch).
 14 Reprogramming of funds within a department, office or agency shall
 15 be effected by the head of such department, office or agency by
 16 specifying in writing to the Secretary of Finance and
 17 Administration, FSM National Government, the accounts for which
 18 funding is either increased or decreased. The President shall
 19 report to Congress within one month of the last day of each
 20 financial quarter all amounts reprogrammed inter or intra a
 21 department, office or agency.

22 Section 12. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 23 date.

24 (1) General Provisions.

25 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be

1 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
2 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
3 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the
4 amended Compact of Free Association between the United
5 States Government and the Government of the Federated
6 States of Micronesia and its related agreements.

7 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for
8 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
9 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in
10 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
11 of the sum appropriated.

12 (2) Allottees. The allottee of the funds appropriated
13 by this act are as follows:

14 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall
15 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

16 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall
17 be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States
18 of Micronesia;

19 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall
20 be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
21 Federated States of Micronesia;

22 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall
23 be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
24 Micronesia;

25 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these

1 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
2 Micronesia, EXCEPT THAT for the following subsections of
3 sections 8 through 9 of this act:

4 (i) Section 8 subsection (12) (a) through (d)
5 - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice
6 of the respective state,

7 (ii) section 9(1) (a) through (d) - the
8 allottee of these funds shall be the President of the
9 College of Micronesia-FSM.

10 Lapse Date. The authority of the allottee to obligate
11 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of
12 September 30, 2009, EXCEPT the funds appropriated under
13 section 9 of this act shall not lapse.

14 Section 13. This act shall become law upon approval by the
15 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
16 becoming law without such approval.
