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A BILL FOR AN ACT

To enact the FY 2008 budget in order to provide funding for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

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1 within the Department of Justice and the Department of Finance and

11 of the last day of each financial quarter all amounts reprogrammed

13 Section 12. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
14 date.

15 (1) General Provisions.

16 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
17 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
18 accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
19 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the  
20 amended Compact of Free Association between the United  
21 States Government and the Government of the Federated  
22 States of Micronesia and its related agreements.

23 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for  
24 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be  
25 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in  
26 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess

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1 of the sum appropriated.

2 (2) Allottees. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
3 by this act are as follows:

4 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall  
5 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

6 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall  
7 be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States

11 Federated States of Micronesia;

12 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall  
13 be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of

15 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these  
16 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of  
17 Micronesia, EXCEPT THAT for the following subsections of  
18 sections 8 through 9 of this act:

19 (i) section 8 subsection (8)(a) through (d)  
20 - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice  
21 of the respective state,

22 (ii) section 9(1)(a) through (d) - the  
23 allottee of these funds shall be the President of the  
24 College of Micronesia-FSM.

25 (3) Lapse Date. The authority of the allottee to  
26 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as

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1           of September 30, 2008, EXCEPT the funds appropriated  
2           under section 9 of this act shall not lapse.

3           Section 9. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
4 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
5 becoming law without such approval.
