A RESOLUTION

To amend the Official Rules of Procedure of the Fifteenth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia.

- 1 WHEREAS the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia is
- 2 governed by its Official Rules of Procedure; and
- 3 WHEREAS Rule 15 of the Official Rules of Procedure stipulates
- 4 that a motion is required to amend the said Rules; and
- 5 WHEREAS a Congressional Resolution is a transparent and open
- 6 mechanism for amendment of the Rules; therefore
- 7 BE IT RESOLVED that Section 1(a) of Rule 6 of the Official
- 8 Rules of Procedure of the Fifteenth Congress of the Federated
- 9 States of Micronesia is amended to read as follows:
- 10 "1(a) Standing Committees. There shall be [six] seven
- 11 standing committees established by these Rules. The standing
- 12 committees shall be organized pursuant to Rules 6 and 7."
- 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Section 3 of Rule 7 of the
- 14 Official Rules of Procedure of the Fifteenth Congress of the
- 15 Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by C.R. No. 15-69, is
- 16 further amended to read as follows:
- 17 "Rule 7. Standing Committees
- 18 Section 3. [Health, Education and Social Affairs].
- 19 (a) The Committee on [Health,] Education [and
- 20 <u>Social Affairs</u>] shall consist of not more than seven
- 21 members with at least one member from each of the four

States. It shall be the duty of this committee to consider and report on all bills, resolutions, and other matters referred to it pertaining to [the preservation of the physical and natural environment; physical and mental health of the general public; public education; public welfare; social security and general well-being of the people of the Federated States of Micronesia]; and other related subjects, including Presidential nominations submitted to the Speaker which require the advice and consent of Congress. It shall be the duty of this committee to consider, investigate, and recommend to the Congress any needed revisions of existing laws or new legislation relating to any subject matter within its jurisdiction.

reviewing specific subjects in the budget of the President, and all supplementals thereto, which make a request for an appropriation which relates to a subject matter within its jurisdiction. Pursuant to its review the committee shall recommend whether the matters referred to it, or portions thereof, will be authorized, and if so, in what amount. Following its review the committee shall promptly report its recommendation to the Congress. Those subjects which fall within the jurisdiction of this committee include, but are not limited to, the following:

13	Official Rules of Procedure of the Fifteenth Congress of the

15	further amended by adding a new section 8 read as follows:
16	"Section 8. Health and Social Affairs.
17	(a) The Committee on Health and Social Affairs
18	shall consist of not more than seven members with at
19	least one member from each of the four States. It shall
20	be the duty of this committee to consider and report on
21	all bills, resolutions, and other matters referred to it
22	pertaining to the preservation of the physical and
23	natural environment; physical and mental health of the
24	general public; public welfare; social security and
25	general well-being of the people of the Federated States
26	of Micronesia; and other related subjects, including

1	Presidential nominations submitted to the Speaker which
2	require the advice and consent of Congress. It shall be
3	the duty of this committee to consider, investigate, and
4	recommend to the Congress any needed revisions of
5	existing laws or new legislation relating to any subject
6	matter within its jurisdiction.
7	(b) This committee shall be responsible for
8	reviewing specific subjects in the budget of the
9	President, and all supplemental requests thereto, which
LO	make a request for an appropriation that relates to a
L1	subject matter within its jurisdiction. Pursuant to its
L2	review the committee shall recommend whether the matters
L3	referred to it, or portions thereof, will be authorized,
L 4	and if so, in what amount. Following its review the
L5	committee shall promptly report its recommendation to
L 6	the Congress. Those subjects that fall within the
L7	jurisdiction of this committee include, but are not
L8	<pre>limited to, the following:</pre>
L 9	(i) Department of Health and Social Affairs;
20	(ii) Office of National Archives, Culture and
21	<u>Historic Preservation.</u>
22	(iii) Office of Gender Development and Women
23	Affairs; and
24	(iv) Office of Youth and Sports"
