

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$500,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year 2010, for the public education in connection with the proposed amendments to the constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia as authorized by Public Law No. 15-60 and Public Law No. 15-61, and for other purposes.

1           Section 1. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from  
2 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the  
3 fiscal year 2010 the sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may be  
4 necessary, for the exclusive purpose of funding public education  
5 activities in connection with the proposed amendments to the  
6 constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia which proposed  
7 amendments are authorized by the Public Law No. 15-60 and Public  
8 Law No. 15-61.

9           Section 2. Programming. Funds appropriated in accordance  
10 with this act are not to be subject to reprogramming.

11           Section 3. Allottee. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
12 by this act shall be the President of the Federated States of  
13 Micronesia.

14           Section 4. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.  
15 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,  
16 administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws,  
17 including, but not limited to the Financial Management Acts of  
18 each of the State, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
19 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so

1 much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose  
2 specified in this act.

3 Section 5. Lapse Date. The authority of the allottee to  
4 obligate all funds appropriated under this act shall lapse as of  
5 September 30, 2011.

6 Section 6. Effective Date. This act shall become law upon  
7 approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or  
8 upon its becoming law without such approval.
