

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 16-18 by amending sections 1 and 2 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, and to offer certain technical amendments thereto, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The title of Public Law No. 16-18 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "To appropriate the sum of \$[~~3,500,000~~] 3,301,000 from
4 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia
5 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, for the
6 purpose of funding Economic and Social Projects and
7 Programs in the States of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and
8 Chuuk, and for other purpose."

9 Section 2. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-18 is hereby
10 amended to read as follows:

11 "Section 1. The sum of \$[~~3,500,000~~] 3,301,000, or so
12 much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated
13 from the General Fund of the Federated States of
14 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
15 2010, for the purpose of funding Economic and Social
16 Projects and Programs in the States of Yap, Kosrae,
17 Pohnpei and Chuuk. The funds appropriated under this
18 section shall be apportioned as follows:

2 Section 3. Section 2 of Public Law No. 16-18 is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
5 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
6 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
7 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
8 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
9 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
10 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
11 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
12 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
13 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
14 under section 1 of this act shall be the President of
15 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
16 PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
17 sections 1(4)(a), (d), ~~and~~ (e) and (f) of this act
18 shall be the Chuuk Commission on Improvement Project
19 (CSCIP). The allottee of funds appropriated under
20 section 1(1) of this act shall be the Governor of the
21 State of Yap. [~~The allottee of funds appropriated under~~
22 ~~section 1(3)(c)(ii)(iv) and (vi) shall be the~~
23 ~~Madolenihmw Menin Keder Lapalap (Mayor of Madolenihmw).]~~
24 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
25 appropriated by this act shall not lapse.

1 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
