

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 16-18, as amended by Public Law No. 16-24, by amending section 1 thereof, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein for the States of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-18, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 16-24, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$3,301,000, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, for the
8 purpose of funding Economic and Social Projects and
9 Programs in the States of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and
10 Chuuk. The funds appropriated under this section shall
11 be apportioned as follows:
