The intent and purpose of Miscellaneous Communication No. 16-79  
is to transmit details of the agreement between the FSM  
government and The Overseas Fishery Cooperation Foundation of  
Japan.

Pursuant to section 114 of Title 24 of the FSM Code, the  
agreement was submitted to Congress for its approval or  
disapproval. Because the agreement was submitted to Congress  
outside of session, the Committee on Ways and Means is  
responsible for acting upon it.

Your committee finds approval of this Goods and Services  
Agreement to be in the best interest of the Federated States of  
Micronesia. The goods and services received, totaling \$272,727,  
will be used for training, research, marketing, processing, and  
operations relating to fisheries activity in Kosrae state.
