

AN ACT

To appropriate \$35,278,975 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The title of this act is as follows: To
2 appropriate the sum of \$35,278,975 from the General Fund of the
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
4 September 30, 2010, for the purpose of funding the operations of
5 all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of
6 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and
7 contributions; and for other purposes. Of the total amount of
8 funds appropriated herein, \$3,800,000 shall be deemed to come from
9 funds available under the amended Compact from education sector;
10 \$0 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
11 Supplemental Education Grant; \$845,333 shall be deemed to come
12 from funds available under the amended Compact from health sector;
13 \$384,107 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
14 amended Compact from capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be
15 deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from
16 private sector development; and \$-0- shall be deemed to come from
17 funds available under the amended Compact from infrastructure
18 sector. The sum appropriated herein shall be apportioned as
19 follows:

20 Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch. The

1 sum of \$14,864,850 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
 2 hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States
 3 of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, for

 6 amount of funds appropriated herein, \$-0- shall be deemed to come
 7 from funds available under the amended Compact from education

 10 from funds available under the amended Compact from health sector;
 11 and \$81,750 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
 12 amended Compact from capacity building sector. The sum

19 Section 11. Reprogramming. Reprogramming of funds into or
20 from the personnel budget line items shall not be permitted. The
21 President, Speaker and Chief Justice may reprogram up to 10% to or
22 from the funds appropriated in sections 2 (Operating expenses of
23 the Executive Branch), 3 (Operating expenses of the Legislative
24 Branch), and 4 (Operating expenses of the National Judicial
25 Branch) respectively. Reprogramming of funds within a department,

1 office or agency shall be effected by the head of such department,
2 office or agency by specifying in writing to the Secretary of
3 Finance and Administration, FSM National Government, the accounts
4 for which funding is either increased or decreased. Reprogramming
5 other than as specified herein is not permitted, and more
6 specifically, reprogramming into or out of any line item contained
7 in Section 8 (Grants, Subsidies & Contributions) or Section 9
8 (Capital and Human Resources) is not permitted. The President
9 shall report to Congress within one month of the last day of each
10 financial quarter all amounts reprogrammed inter or intra a
11 department, office or agency.

12 Section 12. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
13 date.

14 (1) General Provisions.

15 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
16 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance
17 with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
18 Management Act of 1979.

19 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for
20 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
21 are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
22 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated.

23 (2) Allottees. The allottee of the funds
24 appropriated by this act are as follows:

25 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall

1 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

2 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall
3 be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of
4 Micronesia;

5 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall
6 be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated States
7 of Micronesia;

8 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall
9 be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia;

10 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these
11 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
12 Micronesia, EXCEPT THAT for the following subsections of sections
13 8 through 9 of this act:

14 (i) Section 8 subsection (13)(a) through (d)
15 - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the
16 respective State Supreme Court,

17 (ii) section 9(1)(a) through (b) - the allottee of the fund shall
18 be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM.

19 (3) Lapse Date. The authority of the allottee to
20 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of
21 September 30, 2010, EXCEPT the funds appropriated under section 9
22 of this act shall not lapse.

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25 Section 13. This act shall become law upon approval by

1 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon
2 its becoming law without such approval.
