## A RESOLUTION

Ratifying a treaty entitled a Third Arrangement Implementing the Nauru Agreement setting forth additional terms and conditions of access to the Fisheries zones of the Parties.

- 1 WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia is a party to
- 2 the Nauru Agreement Concerning Cooperation in the Management of
- 3 Fisheries of Common Interest, hereinafter referred to as the
- 4 "Nauru Agreement"; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the purpose of the "Nauru Agreement" was to
- 6 ensure that the signatory nations cooperate in the management
- 7 of their respective fisheries zones so that their citizens can
- 8 be assured of receiving he Maximum benefits from their
- 9 resource; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia also ratified
- 11 as a treaty, the first implementing arrangement to the Nauru
- 12 Agreement setting forth the minimum terms and conditions of
- 13 access to the fishery zones of the parties by Congressional
- 14 Resolution No. 2-101; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the treaty entitled "An Agreement Implementing
- 16 the Nauru Agreement setting forth minimum Terms and Conditions
- 17 of Access to the Fishery Zones of the Parties", signed on May
- 18 2, 1982, is a subsidiary agreement to the "Nauru Agreement" and
- 19 necessary for the proper implementation of the "Nauru
- 20 Agreement"; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia also signed as

- 1 an executive agreement the second arrangement implementing the
- 2 Nauru Agreement setting forth additional minimum terms and
- 3 conditions of access to the Fisheries Zones of the Parties,
- 4 which is the second subsidiary agreement to the "Nauru
- 5 Agreement"; and
- 6 WHEREAS, on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of May 2008, six of the eight
- 7 countries to the Parties to the Nauru Agreement signed a third
- 8 arrangement implementing the Nauru Agreement setting forth
- 9 additional terms and conditions of access to the fisheries
- 10 zones of the Parties, which is the third subsidiary agreement
- 11 to the "Nauru Agreement"; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the third Implementing Arrangement imposes
- 13 measures for catch retention by purse seine vessels, restricts
- 14 fishing in the High Seas, imposes a 100 percent observer
- 15 coverage of all purse seine vessels and imposes a condition of
- 16 a license that the automatic location communicator of a
- 17 licensed vessel be switched on and operating properly at all
- 18 times during the period of validity of a license issued by a
- 19 Party; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the third Implementing Arrangement requires
- 21 ratification as a treaty as the Arrangement seeks to impose
- 22 conditions on the High Seas adjacent to the exclusive economic
- 23 zone of the Federated States of Micronesia, in order to ensure
- 24 the sustainability of the Tuna stock; now, therefore,
- 25 BE IT RESOLVED by the Sixteenth Congress of the Federated
