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A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1 and 8 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-28 and 17-31 to appropriate supplemental funding of \$790,059 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended  
2 by Public Laws Nos. 17-28 and 17-31, is hereby amended to read  
3 as follows:

4           "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to  
5 appropriate the sum of \$~~[45,327,053]~~ 46,117,112, or  
6 so much thereof as may be necessary, from the  
7 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia  
8 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, for  
9 the purpose of funding the operations of all  
10 branches of the National Government of the Federated  
11 States of Micronesia, its agencies, various  
12 programs, grants, subsidies and contributions. Of  
13 the total amount of funds appropriated herein,  
14 \$4,437,560 shall be deemed to come from funds  
15 available under the amended Compact from the  
16 education sector subject to the receipt of Grant  
17 Awards under the amended Compact; \$1,176,656 shall  
18 be deemed to come from funds available under the  
19 Supplemental Education Grant; \$878,750 shall be

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1           deemed to come from funds available under the amended  
2           Compact from the health sector subject to the receipt  
3           of Grant Awards under the amended Compact; \$329,598  
4           shall be deemed to come from funds available under  
5           the amended Compact from the capacity building  
6           sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds  
7           available under the amended Compact from the private  
8           sector development sector; and \$1,194,212 shall be  
9           deemed to come from funds available under the  
10          amended Compact from the infrastructure sector."

11          Section 2. Section 8 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended  
12 by Public Laws Nos. 17-28 and 17-31, is hereby amended to read  
13 as follows:

14           "Section 8. Grants, Subsidies and Contributions.

15           The sum of \$~~[9,526,230]~~ 10,316,289, or so much  
16           thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated  
17           from the General Fund of the Federated States of  
18           Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
19           2012, for the following grants, subsidies and  
20           contributions during fiscal year 2012. Of the total  
21           amount of funds appropriated herein, \$-0- shall be  
22           deemed to come from funds available under the amended  
23           Compact from the education sector; and \$-0- shall be  
24           deemed to come from funds available under the  
25           Supplemental Education Grant. The sum appropriated
