

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 17-36, by amending sections 3, 4, 5 and 6 therein, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the States of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, to offer technical amendments, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$2,100,000, or so much thereof as  
2 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
3 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year  
4 ending September 30, 2012, for the purpose of funding public  
5 projects and social programs in the States of Yap, Kosrae,  
6 Pohnpei and Chuuk. The funds appropriated under this section  
7 shall be apportioned as follows:

8 Section 2. Of the sum of \$2,100,000 appropriated by this  
9 act, \$300,000 is apportioned for Yap State for public projects  
10 and social programs.

9       Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
10 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,  
11 managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with  
12 applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial  
13 Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for  
14 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be  
15 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this  
16 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
17 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
18 ~~section[s] 2 [through 5 of this act shall be the President of~~  
19 ~~the Federated States of Micronesia, EXCEPT THAT the allottee of~~  
20 ~~funds appropriated under section 2]~~ of this act shall be the  
21 Governor of Yap State[7]. The allottee of funds appropriated  
22 under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of  
23 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, EXCEPT THAT  
24 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3) (a)  
25 and (b) of section 4 of this act shall be the Pohnpei

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1 Transportation Authority~~[7]~~. ~~[t]~~The allottee of funds  
2 appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of section 5 of  
3 this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee,  
4 EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection  
5 5(6)(a) shall be the President of the Federated States of  
6 Micronesia or his designee, and the allottee of funds  
7 appropriated under subsection 5(6)(f) shall be the President of  
8 COM-FSM. ~~[t]~~The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection  
9 5(2) of section 5 of this act shall be the Mortlock Islands  
10 Development Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
11 subsection 5(3) of section 5 of this act shall be the Executive  
12 Director of the Northern Namoneas Social and Economic  
13 Development Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
14 subsections 5(4) and 5(5) of section 5 of this act shall be the  
15 Chuuk State Commission on Improvement Projects (CSCIP). ~~[and the~~  
16 ~~allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(6)(f) shall~~  
17 ~~be the President of COM-FSM.]~~ The authority of the allottee to  
18 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on  
19 September 30, 2014.

20 Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
21 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
22 becoming law without such approval.
