

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 9 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended by Public Law Nos. 17-28 and 17-52, to amend appropriations for the slipping and life-extension programs for Federated States of Micronesia patrol boats in order to allow for the establishment of a national trading account in managing the maintenance of the patrol boats with assistance a of foreign donor, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended by  
2 Public Law Nos. 17-28 and 17-52, is hereby further amended to read  
3 as follows:

4           "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.

5           The sum of \$11,567,612, or so much thereof as may be  
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
7 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
8 year ending September 30, 2012, for the following  
9 capital improvements, development programs and projects,  
10 and human resources development. Of the total amount of  
11 funds appropriated herein, \$3,800,000 shall be deemed to  
12 come from funds available under the amended Compact from  
13 the education sector subject to the receipt of Grant  
14 Awards under the amended Compact; \$683,346 shall be  
15 deemed to come from funds available under the  
16 Supplemental Education Grant; \$200,000 shall be deemed  
17 to come from funds available under the amended Compact

1 from the health sector subject to receipt of Grant  
 2 Awards under the amended Compact; \$360,000 shall be  
 3 deemed to come from funds available under the amended  
 4 Compact from the infrastructure sector; and \$-0- shall  
 5 be deemed to come from funds available under the amended  
 6 Compact from the capacity building sector. The sum  
 7 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as  
 8 follows:
