

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 8 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-28, 17-31, 17-49, 17-52, and 17-56 to appropriate \$38,390 of supplemental funding for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 17-28, 17-31, 17-52, and 17-56 is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to
5 appropriate the sum of \$~~[46,947,853]~~ 46,986,243, or
6 so much thereof as may be necessary, from the
7 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia
8 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, for
9 the purpose of funding the operations of all
10 branches of the National Government of the Federated
11 States of Micronesia, its agencies, various
12 programs, grants, subsidies and contributions. Of
13 the total amount of funds appropriated herein,
14 \$4,437,560 shall be deemed to come from funds
15 available under the amended Compact from the
16 education sector subject to the receipt of Grant
17 Awards under the amended Compact; \$1,176,656 shall
18 be deemed to come from funds available under the
19 Supplemental Education Grant; \$878,750 shall be

1 deemed to come from funds available under the amended
2 Compact from the health sector subject to the receipt
3 of Grant Awards under the amended Compact; \$329,598
4 shall be deemed to come from funds available under
5 the amended Compact from the capacity building
6 sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds
7 available under the amended Compact from the private
8 sector development sector; and \$1,194,212 shall be
9 deemed to come from funds available under the
10 amended Compact from the infrastructure sector."

11 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended
12 by Public Law No. 17-28, 17-31, and 17-52, is hereby amended to
13 read as follows:

14 "Section 8. Grants, Subsidies and Contributions. The
15 sum of \$~~[9,536,230]~~ 9,574,620, or so much thereof as may
16 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General
17 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
18 fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, for the following
19 grants, subsidies and contributions during fiscal year
20 2012. Of the total amount of funds appropriated herein,
21 \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under
22 the amended Compact from the education sector; and \$-0-
23 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
24 Supplemental Education Grant. The sum appropriated by
25 this section shall be apportioned as follows:
