
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 15-18, 15-26 and 15-33, 15-43, 15-45, 15-49, 15-55 and 15-65 by further amending section 8 thereof, to modify the use of funds previously appropriated therein from the General Fund for fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 8 of Public Law No. 15-11, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 15-18, 15-26, 15-43 and 15-45, is hereby
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 8. Grants, Subsidies and Contributions.

5 The sum of \$6,969,942 or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General
7 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
8 fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, for the
9 following grants, subsidies and contributions during
10 fiscal year 2008. Of the total amount of funds
11 appropriated herein, \$2,777,710 shall be deemed to
12 come from funds available under the amended Compact
13 for Capacity Building, PROVIDED THAT these funds
14 shall not be allocated or obligated until such time
15 as formal approval has been obtained with the Amended
16 Compact of Free Association. The sum appropriated by
17 this section shall be apportioned as follows:
