

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 4 and 6 of Public Law No. 16-49, by changing the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the State of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 16-49, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 16-68, 16-76 and 17-06, is hereby further
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4. Of the sum of \$2,215,000 appropriated by
5 this act, \$610,000 is apportioned for Pohnpei State
6 for public projects and social programs.

14 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 16-49 is hereby
 15 amended to read as follows:

16 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 17 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 18 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 19 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
 20 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
 21 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
 22 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
 23 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
 24 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
 25 appropriated. The allottee of funds appropriated under

1 sections 2 and 4 of this act shall be the President of
2 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
3 PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
4 section 4(1)(b) shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
5 Authority. [~~and the allottee of funds appropriated under~~
6 ~~section 4(1)(c) shall be the Pohnpei Housing Authority.~~]
7 The allottee of funds appropriated under section 3 of
8 this act shall be the Governor of Yap State. The
9 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
10 5(1)(2)(4)(5)(6), (7) and (8) of this act shall be the
11 Chuuk State Commission on Improvement Project (CSCIP).
12 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(3)
13 of this act shall be the Executive Director of the
14 Northern Namoneas Social and Economic Development
15 Authority. The funds appropriated by this act shall
16 remain available until fully expended."

17 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
18 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
19 becoming law without such approval.
