
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate \$43,346,045 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to appropriate
2 the sum of \$43,346,045, or so much thereof as may be necessary, from
3 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
4 fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, for the purpose of funding
5 the operations of all branches of the National Government of the
6 Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs,
7 grants, subsidies and contributions. Of the total amount of funds
8 appropriated herein, \$4,437,560 shall be deemed to come from funds
9 available under the amended Compact from the education sector
10 subject to the receipt of Grant Awards under the amended Compact;
11 \$1,180,608 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
12 Supplemental Education Grant; \$878,750 shall be deemed to come from
13 funds available under the amended Compact from the health sector subject
14 to the receipt of Grant Awards under the amended Compact; \$329,598
15 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended
16 Compact from the capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to
17 come from funds available under the amended Compact from the private
18 sector development sector; and \$834,212 shall be deemed to come from
19 funds available under the amended Compact from the infrastructure

1 sector.

2 Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch. The
3 sum of \$17,662,863, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
4 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of
5 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, for the
6 purpose of funding the operations of the Executive Branch of the
7 National Government during fiscal year 2012. Of the total amount of
8 funds appropriated herein, \$314,493 shall be deemed to come from
9 funds available under the amended Compact from the education sector
10 subject to the receipt of Grant Awards under the amended Compact;
11 \$496,482 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
12 Supplemental Education Grant; \$678,750 shall be deemed to come from
13 funds available under the amended Compact from the health sector
14 subject to the receipt of Grant Awards under the amended Compact; and
15 \$162,450 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
16 amended Compact from the capacity building sector; and \$834,212 shall
17 be deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from
18 the infrastructure sector. The sum appropriated by this section

6 Section 11. Reprogramming. Reprogramming of funds into or
7 from the personnel budget line item shall not be permitted, except
8 when the Department of Foreign Affairs is reprogramming into
9 personnel from contractual services by accessing the contingency
10 fund established in section 2. The President, Speaker and Chief
11 Justice may reprogram up to 10 percent to or from the funds
12 appropriated in sections 2 (Operating expenses of the Executive
13 Branch), 3 (Operating expenses of the Legislative Branch), and 4
14 (Operating expenses of the National Judicial Branch) respectively.
15 Reprogramming of funds within a department, office or agency shall
16 be effected by the head of such department, office or agency by
17 specifying in writing to the Secretary of the Department of Finance
18 and Administration of the FSM National Government, the accounts for
19 which funding is either increased or decreased. Reprogramming other
20 than as specified herein is not permitted, and more specifically,
21 reprogramming into or out of any line item contained in section 8
22 (Grants, Subsidies and Contributions) or section 9 (Investment:

24 report to Congress within one month of the last day of each

2 Section 12. Allotment and management of funds and lapse dates.

3 (1) General provisions.

4 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
5 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with
6 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
7 Management Act of 1979.

8 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring
9 that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
10 solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no
11 obligations are incurred in excess of the sums appropriated.

12 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds appropriated
13 by this act are as follows:

14 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall
15 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

16 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall
17 be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of
18 Micronesia;

19 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall
20 be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated States of
21 Micronesia;

22 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall
23 be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia;

24 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these
25 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

1 PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following subsections of sections 8
2 through 9 of this act:

3 (i) Section 8, subsection (12)(a) through (d)
4 - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the
5 respective State Supreme Court,

6 (ii) Section 9(1)(a) - the allottee of these
7 funds shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM.

8 (3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to
9 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September
10 30, 2012; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds appropriated under
11 section 9 of this act shall not lapse.

12 Section 13. Effective date. This act shall become law upon
13 approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
14 upon its becoming law without such approval.
