

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 16-49, by amending section 5, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-68, 16-76, 17-06 and 17-30, to modify the use of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 16-49, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 16-68, 16-76, 17-06 and 17-30, is hereby
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the sum of \$2,215,000 appropriated by
5 this act, \$1,080,000 is apportioned for Chuuk State for
6 public projects and social programs.
