

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$5,697,383 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013, for the purpose of paying the amount owed by the State Governments to FEMA and to fund public projects and social programs in the States of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

9 Section 1. The sum of \$5,697,383, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
11 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
12 September 30, 2013, for the purpose of paying the amount owed by
13 the State Governments to FEMA and to fund public projects and
14 social programs in the States of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk.
15 The funds appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as
16 follows:

13 Section 2. Of the sum of \$5,697,383 appropriated by this
14 act, \$284,210 is apportioned to pay the amount owed by the State
15 of Yap to FEMA and \$600,000 is apportioned for public projects and
16 social programs in the State of Yap.

7 Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
8 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
9 managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with
10 applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial
11 Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for
12 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
13 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this
14 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
15 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
16 section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State. The
17 allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this
18 act shall be the President of the Federated States of
19 Micronesia or his designee, EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds
20 appropriated under subsection 1 of section 3 of this act shall
21 be the Governor of Kosrae State, the allottee of funds
22 appropriated under subsection 3(2)(p) of this act shall be the
23 Mayor of Lelu Municipal Government or his designee and the
24 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 1 of section 4
25 of this act shall be the Governor of Pohnpei State. The

1 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(1) of this
2 act shall be the President of the Federated States of
3 Micronesia or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated
4 under subsection 5(2)(a) of this act shall be the Governor of
5 Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated
6 under subsection 5(2)(b) of section 5 of this act shall be the
7 Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds
8 appropriated under subsection 5(2)(c) of section 5 of this act
9 shall be the Executive Director of the Northern Namoneas Social
10 and Economic Development Authority or his designee. The
11 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)(d) of
12 section 5 of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
13 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
14 5(2)(e) of section 5 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas
15 Development Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated
16 under subsection 5(2)(f) of this act shall be the Northwest
17 Island Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to
18 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
19 September 30, 2014.

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1 Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
