Your Committee on External Affairs, to which was referred C.R.

Your Committee is mindful of the need for some continuity in the operations of the overseas diplomatic offices. The DCMs contribute substantially to that continuity. More than the ambassadors-who are at the top management and policy levels at the missions-the DCMs are concerned with the day-to-day operations and contacts at the missions. It is therefore imperative that they be confirmed quickly to keep the missions operational.

Your Committee has reviewed the qualifications of the different DCMs, including the nominee, extensively at the time of their initial confirmation. There is no further

need to do so at this time. Your Committee has not heard anything that would cast doubt on the performance of the nominee. During the recently conducted Fiscal Year 2012 budget hearing for the Department of Foreign Affairs, your Committee had a chance to talk to each mission about its performance this past year and the nominee's has been satisfactory. Your Committee also defers to the President and the Department as to the decision to maintain the nominee at his post. Absent any indication to the contrary, your Committee believes the nominee should be reconfirmed, and so recommends Mr. Carl D. Apis be reconfirmed as DCM of the Embassy in China.

Your Committee on External Affairs is in accord with the intent and purpose of C.R. No. 17-08, and recommends its adoption in the form attached hereto.
