impact on the prevention and mitigation of these diseases. This is the second year that funding has been provided.

Your Committee held hearings on March 22 and 26, 2012 at the inception of the project to increase surveillance of infectious disease. At that time the Committee was briefed by the Department of Health and Social Affairs as to the necessity of a project to investigate and mitigate the effects of disease outbreaks, such as the dengue fever outbreak in Yap. The Committee was advised by the Department of Health and Social Affairs that the project is going forward. Your Committee is satisfied with the information provided to it and the overall positive impact this project is having on public health.

Your Committee on Health and Social Affairs is in accord with the intent and purpose of C.R. No. 17-171, and recommends its adoption, subject to the concurrence by the Committee on External Affairs
