Your Committee on Ways and Means, to which was jointly referred C.B. No. 17-204, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND SECTION 672 OF TITLE 55 OF THE CODE OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-66, IN ORDER TO ALLOW EXPENDITURES FOR THE PROVISIONS AND SPARE PARTS OF FSM PATROL AND SURVEILLANCE BOATS TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE MARITIME SURVEILLANCE REVOLVING FUND, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

The intent and purpose of the bill are expressed in its title.

Your Committee concurs with the report of your Committee on Judiciary and Governmental Operations, and notes that the bill, by allowing the Maritime Wing of the FSM National Police to use the Maritime Surveillance Revolving Fund towards the costs of oil, provisions, and spare parts as well as for fuel for FSM patrol and surveillance boats, should increase the number of days the boats can be at sea and thus the amount of revenue generated from penalties and fines due to fishing violations.
