already close relationship with the People's Republic of China and further our work on mutually beneficial issues.

Your Committee reviewed the qualifications of the nominee extensively at the time of his initial confirmation. There is no further need to do so at this time. Your Committee has not received any subsequent communication that would cast doubt on the performance or integrity of the nominee.

During the recently conducted Fiscal Year 2012 budget hearing for the Department of Foreign Affairs, your Committee had a chance to speak with each mission about its performance this past year. At that time the nominee's performance was satisfactory. Your Committee also defers to the President and the Department as to the decision to maintain the nominee in his post. Absent any contrary indication, your Committee believes that the nominee should be confirmed, and so recommends Mr. Akillino Susaia be confirmed as the FSM Ambassador Plenipotentiary to the People's Republic of China.

Your Committee on External Affairs is in accord with the intent and purpose of C.R. No. 17-33, and recommends its adoption in the form attached hereto.
