Your Committee on Ways and Means, to which was referred C.B. No. 17-81, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 15-32, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS 15-36, 15-44, 15-57, 15-63, 15-72, 15-78, 16-03, 16-11, 16-33, 16-46, 17-12 AND 17-21, BY AMENDING SECTION 1 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN FOR THE STATE OF POHNPEI, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

begs leave to report as follows:

A sum of \$3,780,000 was appropriated during the fiscal year 2008, for the purpose of funding social projects and programs in each of the states

In subsection (3)(d) of section 1 of Public Law No. 15-32, referring to "Election District No. 3", Pohnpei State, funds are still available from certain line items. The funds appropriated by this act shall not lapse until fully expended.

The said bill (C.B. No. 17-81) is to change the uses of certain funds, which according to the Department of Finance and Administration, still remain available under the same
