

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$5,100,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the States of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$5,100,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
4 September 30, 2014, for the purpose funding public projects and
5 social programs in the States of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk.
6 The funds appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as
7 follows:

8 Section 2. Of the sum of \$5,100,000 appropriated by this
9 act, \$750,000 is apportioned for public projects and social
10 programs in the State of Yap.

11 Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.

12 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,

13 administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws,

14 including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of

15 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these

16 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for

17 the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are

18 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the

19 funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the

20 Governor of Yap State. The allottee of funds appropriated under

21 sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of the

22 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee EXCEPT THAT the

23 funds appropriated under subsections a, b, c, d, e, f, g, h, i, j,

24 k, l, m, n, o, s, t, u, v, w, x and ag, ah and aj of this act

25 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee. The

1 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(3) of
2 this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee.
3 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this
4 act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The
5 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act
6 shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The
7 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act
8 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The allottee of funds
9 appropriated under subsection 5(6) of this act shall be the
10 General Manager of the Northwest Island Development Authority.
11 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by
12 this act shall lapse on September 30, 2015.

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25 Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the

1 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
2 becoming law without such approval.
