

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-05, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-07, 18-14, 18-31 [~~and 18-38~~], 18-38 and 18-72, by amending [~~section 6~~] sections 2, 4 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and lapse date of certain funds previously appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No 18-05, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 18-07, 18-14 and 18-72, is hereby further
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 2. Of the sum of \$2,500,000 appropriated
5 by this act, \$400,000 is apportioned for Kosrae
6 State for public projects and social programs.

17 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-05, as amended by
 18 Public Laws Nos. 18-07 and 18-38, is hereby further amended to
 19 read as follows:

20 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
 21 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
 22 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for
 23 in accordance with applicable laws, including, but
 24 not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.
 25 The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that

1 these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
2 are used solely for the purpose specified in this
3 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
4 of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds
5 appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the
6 Governor of Yap State. The allottee of funds
7 appropriated under sections 2 and 4 of this act shall
8 be the President of the Federated States of
9 Micronesia or his designee, EXCEPT THAT the allottee
10 of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(a) of
11 this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
12 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
13 subsections 5(1) and 5(3) of this act shall be the
14 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The
15 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)
16 of section 5 of this act shall be the Mortlock
17 Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds
18 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of section 5 of
19 this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
20 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
21 subsection 5(5) of section 5 of this act shall be the
22 Faichuk Development Authority. The allottee of funds
23 appropriated under subsection 5(6) of section 5 of
24 this act shall be the Northwest Island Development
25 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate

1 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
2 September 30, [~~2014~~] 2015."

3 [~~Section 2~~] Section 4. This act shall become law upon
4 approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
5 or upon its becoming law without such approval.
