A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend section 228 of title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, to require any revision or addition of Project Control Documents to comply with the Administrative Procedures Act set forth in title 17 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, to offer a technical amendment, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Policy and Purpose. The purpose of this bill is  
2 to ensure the that revisions or the addition of any requirements  
3 for Project Control Documents (PCD's) follow the Administration  
4 Procedures Act, title 17 of the Code of the Federated States of  
5 Micronesia. This requirement will allow for public notice and  
6 comment upon any proposed changes in PCD's

7           Section 2. Section 228 of title 55 of the Federated States  
8 of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9           "Section 228. Rules and regulations.

10           (1) The Secretary of Finance and Administration is  
11 hereby authorized to issue and promulgate rules and  
12 regulations implementing the provisions of this chapter  
13 which, upon approval by the President of the Federated  
14 States of Micronesia, shall have force and effect of law.

15           (2) The requirement for, amendments of, or revisions  
16 made to Project Control Documents must be done in  
17 accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, title  
18 17 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia.

1                   (3) The requirement for, amendments of, or revisions  
2                   made to Project Control Documents shall not constitute an  
3                   imminent peril to public health, safety, or welfare under  
4                   title 17 section 102 (2) of the Code of the Federated  
5                   States of Micronesia.”

6           Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
7   President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
8   becoming law without such approval.
