

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget of \$550,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States for fiscal year ending September 30, 2015, by amending section 9 of Public Law No. 18-89, to fund the renovation of the Washington D.C. embassy building, to correct technical errors, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 18-89 is hereby amended
2 to read as follows:

3 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.

4 The sum of or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
5 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of
6 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2015, for
7 the following capital improvements, development programs, and
8 projects and human resources development. Of the total
9 amount of funds appropriated herein, [~~\$2,383,346~~] \$1,700,000
10 [~~shall be deemed~~] will be available from the amended Compact
11 Sector for COM-FSM, and \$683,346 will be available from the
12 Supplemental Education Grant. The sum appropriated by this
13 section shall be apportioned as follows:
