

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-70, as amended by Public Law No. 18-98 by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated for public projects and social programs for the States of Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 18-70, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 18-98, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 4. Of the sum of \$5,100,000 appropriated by
4 this act, \$1,450,000 is apportioned for public projects
5 and social programs in the State of Pohnpei.

12 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-70, as amended by
 13 Public Law No. 18-98, is hereby further amended to read as
 14 follows:

15 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 16 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 17 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 18 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
 19 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
 20 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
 21 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
 22 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
 23 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
 24 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
 25 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap

1 State EXCEPT THAT the funds appropriated under
2 subsection 2(i) shall be the President of COM-FSM. The
3 allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of
4 this act shall be the President of the Federated States
5 of Micronesia or his designee EXCEPT THAT the funds
6 appropriated under subsections a, b, c, d, e, f, g, h,
7 i, j, k, l, m, n, o, s, t, u, v, w, x and ag, ah and aj
8 of section 3 this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town
9 Government or his designee [~~and~~]; the funds appropriated
10 under subsections a, b, c, d, e, f and g of section 4(1)
11 and section 4[~~(2)~~](3)(p) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
12 Transportation Authority, and the funds appropriated
13 under subsection 4(3)(t) shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of
14 Kitti. The allottee of funds appropriated under
15 subsection 4(1)(h) shall be the President of the
16 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee. The
17 allottee of funds appropriate under subsection 4(2)(g)
18 of this act shall be the Administrator of the MiCare
19 program. The allottee of funds appropriated under
20 subsections 5(1) and 5(3) of this act shall be the
21 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee
22 of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act
23 shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority.
24 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4)
25 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development

1 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
2 subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk
3 Development Authority. The allottee of funds
4 appropriated under subsection 5(6) of this act shall be
5 the General Manager of the Northwest Island Development
6 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
7 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
8 30, 2015."

9 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
10 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
11 becoming law without such approval.
