This is also an on-going project by the Department of Health and Social Affairs to improve the data tracking for the Department. This project is known to the Committee from previous years. Funding would continue to support the web-based data collection and reporting system for the Nation. Specifically, the funds would be used to complete the assessments and conduct on-site training, enhancement and upgrades of the system in all the four States. The budget for this year's grant is as follows: personnel \$24,828, travel \$47,413, supplies \$2,000, contractual services \$20,048 and other expenses \$5,711.

Your Committee believes that the retention of correct and secure data for the Department of Health and Social Affairs is important. Your Committee on Health and Social Affairs is in accord with the intent and purposes of C.R. No. 18-93, and recommends its adoption in the form attached hereto.
