Your Committee on Ways & Means, to which was referred C.B. No. 18-30,
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 17-68,
AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 17-71, 17-81, 17-84,
17-89, AND 18-03, BY AMENDING SECTION 6 THEREOF,
FOR THE PURPOSE OF CHANGING THE ALLOTTEE THEREIN,
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.",

begs leave to report as follows:

The intent and purpose of the bill are expressed in its title.

Your Committee notes that C.B. No. 18-30 requests no new funding for
public projects, but to change the allottee of fund, especially fund
previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in
Election No. 2, Chuuk State.

In Public Law No. 18-03, the allottee of funds previously appropriated
under Election District No., was inadvertently omitted, and the
President has designated himself as the allottee of funds appropriated
for Election District No. 2, Chuuk State. The proposed amendment is
to designate the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee as the
