

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-71, 17-81, 17-84, 17-89, 17-90, 18-03, 18-10, 18-13, 18-32 and 18-46, by amending sections 4 and 6 therein, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the State of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 17-71, 17-84, 18-32 and 18-46, is hereby further
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4. Of the sum of \$5,697,383 appropriated by
5 this act, \$219,116 is apportioned to pay the amount
6 owed by the State of Pohnpei to FEMA and \$1,200,000
7 is apportioned for public projects and social
8 programs in the State of Pohnpei.

18 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by
 19 Public Laws Nos. 17-71, 18-03 and 18-13, is here by further
 20 amended to read as follows:

21 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 22 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 23 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 24 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
 25 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The

1 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
2 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
3 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
4 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
5 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
6 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
7 State. The allottee of funds appropriated under
8 sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of
9 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee,
10 EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
11 subsection 1 of section 3 of this act shall be the
12 Governor of Kosrae; the allottee of funds appropriated
13 under subsections 3(2)(j), (k), (l), (m), (n), (o), (p),
14 (q), (r), (s), (t), (u), (v), (w), (x), (y), (z), (aa),
15 (ab), (ac), (ad), (ae), (af), (ag) and (ah) of section 3
16 of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Municipal
17 Government or his designee; the allottee of funds
18 appropriated under subsection 1 of section 4 of this act
19 shall be the Governor of Pohnpei State and the allottee
20 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(c)(xxiii) and
21 4(c)(xxiv) of section 4 of this act shall be the
22 Meninkeder lapalap, Madolenihmw Municipal Government.
23 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)
24 of this act shall be the President of the Federated
25 States of Micronesia or his designee. The allottee of

1 funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)(a) and 5(2)(c)
2 of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
3 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
4 subsection 5(2)(b) of section 5 of this act shall be the
5 Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The allottee of
6 funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)(d) of section 5
7 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
8 Authority or its designee. The allottee of funds
9 appropriated under subsection 5(2)(e) of section 5 of
10 this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority or
11 its designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
12 subsection 5(2)(f) of section 5 of this act shall be the
13 Northwest Island Development Authority. The authority
14 of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this
15 act shall lapse on September 30, 2014."

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24 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the

1 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
2 becoming law without such approval.
