

A RESOLUTION

Approving and accepting a grant in the amount of \$3,000 from the International Information and Networking Centre for Intangible Cultural Heritage in the Asia Pacific (ICHCAP), to fund promotional events for the Pacific traditional knowledge publication entitled: "Traditional Knowledge and Wisdom: Themes from Pacific Islands' in the FSM.", including all the terms and conditions of the assistance.

1 WHEREAS, the ICHCAP entered into an agreement with the
2 National Archives, Culture and Historic Preservation Office on
3 July 3, 2012, to provide \$3,000 to promote and support an event
4 for the publication: "Traditional Knowledge and Wisdom: Themes
5 from the Pacific Islands' in the FSM"; and

6 WHEREAS, the purpose of the assistance is to fund the
7 activities of the National Archives, Culture and Historic
8 Preservation Office in promoting this publication; and

9 WHEREAS, the FSM government expresses appreciation to the
10 ICHCAP for the financial assistance made available to the
11 Federated States of Micronesia; and

12 WHEREAS, section 210(2) of the Code of the Federated States
13 of Micronesia provides that for an agreement of foreign financial
14 assistance to be valid it must be approved by Congress by
15 resolution; now, therefore

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Eighteenth Congress of the Federated
17 States of Micronesia, Seventh Special Session, 2015, that Congress
18 hereby approves and accepts the \$3,000 grant a from the

1 International Information and Networking Centre for Intangible
2 Cultural Heritage in the Asia Pacific, to fund promotional events
3 for the Pacific traditional knowledge publication entitled:
4 "Traditional Knowledge and Wisdom: Themes from Pacific Islands' in
5 the FSM.", including all the terms and conditions thereof; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
7 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
8 of Micronesia, and the Acting Director the National Archives,
9 Culture and Historic Preservation Office.
