

A RESOLUTION

Approving and accepting a grant assistance in the amount of \$10,000 from the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women, to fund the implementation of the Convention on Elimination of Discrimination Against Women and the Convention on the Rights of the Child state reporting project, including all the terms and conditions of the assistance.

1 WHEREAS, on March 5, 2013, the United Nations Entity for
2 Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women extended to the
3 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia a grant
4 assistance in the amount of \$10,000, as evidence by the Annual
5 Work Plan of the same date; and

6 WHEREAS, the grant assistance was awarded to the Federated
7 States of Micronesia for the specific purpose of funding the
8 implementation of the Convention on Elimination of
9 Discrimination Against Women and the Convention on the Rights
10 of the Child state reporting project; and

11 WHEREAS, section 210(2) of title 55 of the Code of the
12 Federated States of Micronesia provides that for an agreement
13 on foreign financial assistance to be valid it must be approved
14 by Congress by resolution; and

15 WHEREAS, the FSM Government is grateful and appreciative
16 to the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the
17 Empowerment of Women for the benevolent assistance; now,
18 therefore,

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Eighteenth Congress of the Federated

1 States of Micronesia, First Special Session, 2013, that
2 Congress hereby approves and accepts the grant assistance in
3 the amount of \$10,000 from the United Nations Entity for Gender
4 Equality and the Empowerment of Women, to fund in the
5 implementation of the Convention on Elimination of
6 Discrimination Against Women and the Convention on the Rights
7 of the Child state reporting project; and

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
9 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated
10 States of Micronesia, and the United Nations Entity for Gender
11 Equality and the Empowerment of Women.
