
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget in the amount of \$4,833,428 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, by amending sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 19-32, as amended by Public Law No. 19-45, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-32, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 19-45, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

5 follows: To appropriate the sum of [~~\$75,542,323~~

7 of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,

10 States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs,
11 grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human
12 Resources Development. The National Government's share
13 of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero
14 except that the National Government will retain 10
15 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is
16 reflected in the budget for the Department of Education.

 25 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

1 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for
2 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
3 necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in
4 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
5 of the sums appropriated.

6 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds
7 appropriated by this act are as follows:

8 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds
9 shall be the President of the Federated States of
10 Micronesia;

11 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds
12 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated
13 States of Micronesia;

14 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds
15 shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
16 Federated States of Micronesia;

17 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds
18 shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
19 Micronesia;

20 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of
21 these funds shall be the President of the Federated
22 States of Micronesia; PROVIDED HOWEVER, that for the
23 following subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this
24 act:

25 (i) Section 8(6)(g) - the allottee shall be

1 the President of the College of Micronesia – FSM; and
2 (ii) Section 8(6)(h) through (i) – the
3 allottee of these funds shall be the Governor of the
4 State of Chuuk;
5 (iii) All subsections under Section 8(9) –
6 the allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker of the
7 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia; and
8 (iv) Section 8(12)(a) through (d) – the
9 allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the
10 respective State Supreme Court;
11 (v) Section 8(12)(n) – the allottee of these
12 funds shall be the Speaker of Congress of the Federated
13 States of Micronesia.
14 (vi) Section 9(1)(a) through (c) – the
15 allottee of these funds shall be the President of the
16 College of Micronesia-FSM;
17 (vii) Section 9(12)(a)(ii) – the allottee of
18 these funds shall be Governor of Chuuk State[~~;~~ PROVIDED
19 THAT, the Governor shall submit the proposed uses of said
20 funds in accordance with priorities of Chuuk State to the
21 Chuuk State Legislature for its consideration and
22 action].
23 (viii) Section 9(12)(b)-(d) – the allottee of
24 these funds shall be the Governor of the respective
25 states.
